

GUIDANCE NOTES ON USING ST BONIFACE CHURCH FOR PRIVATE PRAYER AUGUST 2020

Please read this information, to ensure we all stay safe and give each parishioner time for prayer.

- We must practise social distancing at all times.
- A face covering must be worn at all times unless you have a medical exemption. (Those under the age of 11 are exempt).
- Please use the hand sanitizer on entering as well as leaving the church.
- The rear of the church is restricted as is the front of the church. Where you see a red cross please stay clear of that area
- One lone person or one household, wishing to pray, will be allowed in church at any one time.
- You will be shown to an allocated pew. Please sit near the wall, away from the aisle if possible.
- Your time for private prayer may need to be limited if a large number of people are waiting outside.
- There will be no toilet facilities available at this time.
- Please indicate to the steward when you wish to leave so that social distancing rules are maintained at all times.
- People using their own wheel chairs please work with the steward to ensure the safest place to pray, whilst maintaining social distancing.
- If the church is being used please give your name to the steward and then wait in the churchyard or in your car. You will be called when it is your turn.
- You will be given a leaflet with this information when you enter church. Please take it away with you afterwards for future use or dispose of it on the way out in the bin provided.
- Please bear with us in these challenging times.
